

- USMLE Easy Step 1 includes USMLE-format questions plus general knowledge questions separately available.

USMLE Step 2 CK is the second in the series of three USMLE exams that candidates must pass in order to qualify for medical licensure in the United States. Step 2 CK assesses whether you can apply medical knowledge, skills, and understanding of clinical science essential for the provision of patient care under supervision and includes emphasis on health promotion and disease prevention. This exam ensures that due attention is devoted to principles of clinical sciences and basic patient-centered skills that provide the foundation for the safe and competent practice of medicine.

- USMLE Easy Step 2 CK includes USMLE-format questions plus general knowledge questions separately available.

USMLE Step 3 is the final exam in the series of the three that candidates must pass in order to qualify for medical licensure in the United States. This exam assesses residents' ability to apply medical knowledge and understanding of biomedical and clinical science essential for the unsupervised practice of medicine, with emphasis on patient management in ambulatory settings. Step 3 provides a final assessment of physicians assuming independent responsibility for delivering general medical care.

- USMLE Easy Step 3 includes USMLE vignette-format questions and general knowledge questions separately available.
